



General Notes:

- 1. The Zero Point is the intersection of the Datum Water Line (dwl) with the stemface.
- 2. Positions are measured fwd and aft (marked "-") of the Zero Point.
- 3. Heights are measured above and below (marked "-") the dwl.
- 4. Offsets are measured each side of the fore-&-aft centreline.
- 5. Waterlines are designated "wl" followed by their height.
- 6. Buttocks are designated "b" followed by their offset.
- '. Diagonals are designated "d" followed by their start height on the centreline and their angle to it.
- 8. Offsets on diagonals are measured down the angle of the diagonal.
- 9. Offsets are to inside of skin unless noted otherwise.
